

Updated School COVID Plan for Students

After reviewing the Alabama Dept of Public Health plan, discussing with medical personnel, and looking at other schools plans, we will begin this school board approved COVID plan immediately:

Exposure with no symptoms – can attend school but avoid close contact with others as much as possible for five days.

Exposure with symptoms – Isolated from school for five days and can return to school on the sixth day of exposure if no symptoms are present. If symptoms are still present remain at home until they are gone.

Positive – A student that tests positive will not be able to attend school or school functions for five days and can return to school on the sixth day or after if symptoms are not present. If symptoms are present remain at home until they are gone or you can return with a negative test. A student that has tested positive will have their temperature checked in the office as soon as they arrive back to school.

Masks are not required unless a teacher with immune deficiencies ask for students in their class to wear one when the teacher is in close contact with the student.

Please make sure there is no fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medicine before returning to school.

No plan can take the place of common sense and concern for others.

It is very much appreciated if you let the school know if your child tests positive.

The plan can be adapted to the number of positive cases we incur.
